I am very concerned about the proposed Philips 66 spur line for many reasons:

1. There are already significant concerns about the air quality on the Nipomo Mesa. This project would have an additional severe impact, increasing asthma and other respiratory problems among local residents. | HAO-01

2. Nipomo Mesa is intended to be a residential area. The proposed Rail Terminal would lead to visual, light and noise pollution and would remove the buffer zone between residents and the refinery. | HAO-02

3. County emergency services would have to be prepared to respond to a major catastrophe as mile-long trains full of oil would pass through the county daily. This would require significant funding to achieve and maintain the necessary level of readiness. | HAO-03

For all these reasons, I believe that the proposed project will have a detrimental effect in public health and also on our environment and I urge you to turn down thisplannign application. | HAO-04
