Dear San Luis Obispo County Commissioners and Supervisors,

Please deny the proposed oil-by-rail project at the Phillips 66 Santa Maria Refinery.

Those tracks run through my community, Berkeley CA, as well. I don't believe it's in either of our interests to bring in tar sand bombs into our community, with their decent potential to devastate our communities over a year of shipments. The safety history is poor.

Bringing tar sands to California additionally undermines our state's efforts to be a global leader addressing climate change, and these trains will put our communities directly in harm's way.

I urge the San Luis Obispo County Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors to soundly reject the Phillips 66 proposed rail spur.
