I am a resident of Sacramento, California, and the proposed 80-car crude-oil train headed to the Santa Maria refinery 5 days a week will travel through Sacramento. I am concerned for a number of reasons.

First, Oil trains create toxic air pollution every mile they travel in California. This is a problem for every community the train passes through.
