If the rail spur is allowed to go through our community will no longer be the desired location for travelers. Are these effects to be allowed just so Phillips can increase their bottom line? How will our elected officials keep us safe?

The proposed Phillips rail spur project would result in 250 crude by rail trains, 1.5 miles long with 80 each oil filled DOT-111 tankers moving through our community annually. These DOT-111 tankers have been found to be inadequate for safety by the Federal Transportation Department and at high risk for explosion. I urge the County Planning Department to recommend a "NO" project to the Board of Supervisors.
