As a business professional and one that understands corporate responsibility and long term growth and profitability, I have been interested in the proposal for Phillips 66 to expand their facility to handle rail cars of crude oil.

However, the more I learned about the proposal, the more concerned I became over the impact on the adjacent areas.

My primary concerns are:

- a. Light Pollution: Even with cut-off light fixtures, there will be an uplight component, impacting the dark sky benefits of neighboring communities.
- b. Noise: 24 hour, seven days a week track/engine noise affecting neighboring communities.
- c. Safety of rail car transportation to the site.

The benefit is not measured jobs or refinery capacity, but decreased raw material cost and higher profit levels for the corporation: simply, THERE ARE NO LOCAL BENEFITS.

This expansion project is not in the best interests of San Luis Obispo County residents and I urge the SLO Planning Commission to stop this proposal.
