Thank you for taking the time to read this email. I am writing as an individual, but from the perspective of an educator and member of my local school board. I am concerned about the expansion of the Phillips 66 rail terminal, because those trains go past the schools in our area. Many of our schools are within 50 feet of rail lines, and there is a chance for an oil train disaster.

I am old enough to remember the Santa Barbara coastline oil disaster that occurred in 1969. The idea of an oil disaster so close to our schools is very disconcerting. There is also reporting that these oil transporting trains impact air pollution and other environmental concerns. Please consider rejecting the expansion of the terminal.
