Subject: Phillips 66 Rail Terminal Project

Dear Mr. Murry Wilson - SLO County Planning Department,

My husband and I are shocked by the realities of the Phillips 66 Rail Terminal Project and by the lack of meaningful publicity concerning it. We read newspapers and internet coverage, watch news on TV and stay abreast of local, state, U.S. and world goings-on. At first, Phillips 66 downplayed this project as just small additions on their own land. There was little information in the news about the proposal.

Now we find that it is not just a "Rail Terminal Project," but a matter of bringing 520 oil trains, each one a mile and a half long and filled with highly toxic materials, through SLO County (and through the state), for five days of every week. This is outrageous.

The impact of such a project would be devastating to SLO County. Material about this proposal should have been sent to every household in the County. The breadth of the project should have been discussed extensively in the local print and screen news. Residents should have been given ample time to respond to such a proposal.

How could we in SLO County rejoice over President Obama and the President of China making an historical pledge to address climate change, and turn around within weeks to consider the increased use of fossil fuels in our area? We need the SLO County Planning Department to put an end to this proposal immediately.
