The marginal need in our current economy for the magnitude of increased oil
shipments proposed for the P66 refinery is outweighed by the great danger of
these shipments to cities along the rail line, including Davis.

your jurisdiction, it is wrong for your board to unilaterally allow a project
that should be evaluated at the state and national level.
