As residents of the Trilogy at Monarch Dunes in Nipomo, we would like to personally voice our serious concerns about the proposed Rail Spur Extension by the Phillips 66 Refinery. The Rail Spur Extension has the potential for significant environmental impact on our air quality, local crops and water quality. As we have seen around the country, with an increase in trains transporting oil by rail cars, there has been an increase in the number of oil rail car accidents, some in populated areas.
