My husband, Paul, and myself, would like to strongly voice our opposition to the proposed Phillips 66 Rail Terminal. The risks of the proposal far outweigh the benefits. This proposal is unacceptable on EVERY level. As residents of Trilogy Monarch Dunes we would be particularly affected by the terminal. This is a residential area and zoned as such. We currently enjoy a scenic vista along Via Concha/Louise/Eucalyptus roads, not to mention from our public golf course. The resulting noise, visibility of facility, air pollution and congestion in these areas and along Willow Road are UNACCEPTABLE to our community.

The Phillips 66 Rail Terminal Proposal would result in not only the loss of our beautiful views of the ocean and dunes but more importantly potential safety and health issues. Our nights would be subjected to the noise of the facility and lights that will "showcase" the offloading facility.

The Phillips 66 proposal should be unacceptable to all of SLO county. The noise, pollution in excess of SLO CAPD thresholds, and safety issues affect the entire county with the impact of 1.5 mile long trains, each hauling 80 crude oil tankers, potential for oil spills, fires and explosions. The alarming statistics of other similar projects speak to these potential hazards. Phillips proposal appears to be either naïve in their presentation of the facts or intentionally misrepresenting the facts, and dangers, of such a facility. They have used outdated statistics and can only be motivated by their own corporate greed and benefits. Until now
