

CREDO Action Comments and Responses

Comment

I am writing to oppose Phillips 66's expansion plans for the Santa Maria and Rodeo refineries. The plan represents a catastrophic threat to communities and major population centers in the oil train blast zone, will increase toxic air pollution in refinery communities, and will substantially increase global warming pollution, exacerbating the threat effecting all of California of crippling drought and massive wildfires. Californians are depending on our public officials to stop dangerous fossil fuel expansion that poses so many threats to our health, safety and future in California.
