Notice to Permit Holder:

In accordance with the San Luis Obispo County Building and Construction Ordinance, Title 19 of the San Luis Obispo County Code, permit **applications** shall expire by limitation if the application is not issued within 360 days from the date of issuance.

The building official may grant an extension of time to a person holding a valid permit application upon written request stating the reasons for not continuing the application process. Time extensions shall not exceed 180 days. Permits shall not be extended more than once. A Board of Supervisors one time extension was passed on July 28, 2009 allowing an extension until December 31, 2010 if the proper requests are completed and fees paid. (see over)

Requesting: Application date extension to _____ 180 day one time maximum extension from 360 days from date of application or extension to December 31, 2010 (Title 19 one time extension policy - see back).

The San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors took action on 7/28/09 to approve amendments to the Building and Construction Ordinance that would provide applicants additional time for issuance of a construction permit. The current economic times have made it difficult for applicants to acquire financing within the existing timeframes set by the ordinance. The amendments authorize the extension of construction permits until December 31, 2010.

This ordinance only affects construction permit applications that have not been issued.

Applicants interested in extending their permit applications will need to submit a Request for Application Extension form, an Application Extension Policy form (if applicable) and pay the required fee:

Construction permit applications submitted to the County after January 1, 2008 will require:

- A Request For Application Extension form
- Payment of a \$66.50 processing fee

Construction permit applications submitted to the County prior to January 1, 2008 will require:

- A Request For Application Extension form
- An Application Extension Policy form (agreement to meet select updated code requirements in their projects in order to qualify for the extension).
- Payment of a \$399.00 review fee.
- Extra plan review may be required to comply with Wildland Urban Interface Requirements.
