**SUBJECT: Chevron Tank Farm Remediation and Development Project Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR)**

The Final EIR for the Chevron Tank Farm Project has been completed and is now available for public review. The Final EIR includes responses to comments that were received by the City of San Luis Obispo during the EIR public review period and as public testimony from the July 8, 2013 public workshop held before the Planning Commission. Pursuant to Section 15088 of the State Guidelines for implementation of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) the lead agency is required to provide responses to agency comments; however, the City of San Luis Obispo has elected to provide responses to all interested parties that commented on the project. Responses to comments were prepared by the consultant and reviewed by City staff.

Changes to the text of the document made since the review of the Draft EIR (either additions or deletions) have been incorporated directly into the Final EIR.

Review of the Final EIR and the various project entitlements have been tentatively scheduled for the Planning Commission meeting of January 22, 2014, and the City Council on March 18, 2014.
