I chose to live in this town due to the quit nature of the town and the proximity of the elementary school to my home. I am the mother of 2 children one attended the school from K through 6th and my second is set to start school this school year. My oldest was able to walk and ride to and from the school without any difficulty. My youngest however would not enjoy this if the road he would have to cross was to have an additional 200 trucks making daily trip to and from the quarry. Along with the impact on the school the down town area would suffer as a result of the increased traffic through town. The ability to walk 3 blocks from my home to get a cup of coffee and a meal while sitting outside would be impeded due to the increased traffic. Children frequently enjoy walking down town due to the relative safety of the town if the quarry was opened the increased traffic would reduce the safety.

Based on the traffic at the Hansson Quarry early mornings would see a significant increase in truck traffic as early loads would create traffic congestion along hwy. 58 as this is a narrow winding road with little to no shoulder this would mean trucks parked on the hwy. blocking access to homes that are along this road. This area is a high fire risk to have traffic impeded would slow the emergency response time to these areas. The increased demand for water as a result of this quarry in the area would reduce the ability of homeowners to protect there property in the event of a fire.

Please do not approve such a destructive business in a town that has worked so hard to be a quiet safe town.
