Dear Mr. Oliveira:

There are many ways the proposed Highway 58 quarry will have a negative impact on the community but the one I wish to emphasize is traffic. I travel Highway 58 daily, as I live right off 58 about nine miles outside of the town of Santa Margarita. It is a very curvy two lane road. In many places the shoulder is non-existent. There is no bicycle lane. There are very few places to pull over to let faster traffic pass. Some of the turns are so sharp that the normal 55 mph speed limit is reduced to 30 mph.

Turning off of El Camino onto the highway necessitates crossing a railroad track and the distance from the track to El Camino is 50 feet, 16 feet too short for a double trailer truck. Immediately past the railroad tracks you come up to a school crossing zone.

All of these problems, sharp curves, no shoulder, not enough room to clear the railroad tracks, kids crossing to go to the public school, no bicycle lane, are dangers that cannot be ignored and, I believe, a reason to not permit this quarry to proceed.
