I believe is is completely inappropriate for the huge number of expected trucks to be on the highway in the areas around and thru Santa Margarita, where I have lived for the past 10 years. Public safety, including that of school children, the resulting air pollution, noise pollution and the huge use of our areas' water, and the destruction of the mountain where the granite rock is deposited are all concerns, any one of which should be cause enough for us to stop this development.

In addition, the expected use of "I" Street as an alternate route for thru traffic by residents and those of surrounding areas presents a real concern for me. I live on "I" Street and am acutely aware of hazardous traffic, primarily speeding, on this long street. The presence of the stop signs which were installed several years ago make scant difference today, and I expect will make even less difference when the traffic load increases due to the virtual takeover of Hwy 58 by the quarry operation. The thought of speeding commuters on a residential street with children and animals constantly present should be enough for you to reject this reckless proposal.

Please listen to me and the rest of the community who are asking you to reject this proposed operation.
