My name is Donna Lipe. I live at 10725 Little Quail Lane, Santa Margarita, 93453.

I am concerned about the impacts of the proposed Hwy 58 quarry.

My highest concern is the estimated 200 truck trips PER DAY on Hwy 58 & through Santa Margarita.

This area has a high number of bicycle events throughout the year as well as recreational riders on a daily basis. Semi trucks and bicycles on a narrow, winding road with no bike lane is a fatality waiting to happen.

The roads need to be wider, with bike lanes.

The bridges need to be reinforced and made wider.

There needs to be stoplight at the entrance to the quarry. People tend to speed through that section.

A couple of my other concerns are water and noise.

Where are they getting the 20,000 gallons of water a day from and what is that going to do to MY water table over 30 years?

If I can hear the train whistle as it goes through Santa Margarita, I'm sure as heck gonna be hearing their explosives going off. It's bad enough when someone decides to target practice a couple miles away. I cannot imagine how nerve wracking constant EXPLOSIONS are going to be.
