

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2008 ACTION PLAN TO ALLOCATE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT RECOVERY ACT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS**

WHO: A public hearing will be held by the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors

WHEN AND WHERE: Tuesday, June 2, 2009, 9:00 AM in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, County Government Center, San Luis Obispo. (All hearings are scheduled for 9:00 A.M. To determine placement of this item on the agenda, please contact the County Administrative Office the Thursday afternoon before the hearing date).

WHAT IS PROPOSED: The County of San Luis Obispo requests a substantial amendment to the Urban County of San Luis Obispo 2008 Annual Action Plan for the allocation of Community Development Block Grant Recovery Act Program (CDBG-R). The Urban County is to receive \$559,246 in CDBG-R funds and is required to amend the Urban County of San Luis Obispo 2008 Action Plan for the award of the program funds. The substantial amendment will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development before June 5, 2009, for review and approval.

The CDBG-R grant is authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. All interested persons may express their views and opinions regarding the CDBG-R grant at the public hearing, or provide such comments in writing and signed, as identified in this notice.
