
## WHAT'S HAPPENING WITH THE SEWER PROJECT?

The pipelines are complete and the water recycling facility is well underway. It will be ready for connections in early 2016.

It's not too early to begin planning for connection to the sewer in 2016 – we already are! In the coming months, we will be providing you with more important information including:

- Financial assistance, grants and loans for those who qualify
- Permits and construction planning
- Green options for re-purposing septic systems

## WHAT WILL THE SEWER COST ME?

With connections scheduled for less than two years from now, many people are concerned about the financial impact the sewer will have on them. Beginning in mid-2016, sewer charges are expected to be \$165/month for a typical single family home. Multi-family and mobile homes will be approximately \$85 to \$125.

In addition, a recent survey shows that more than 80% of homes already have low flow fixtures. **If you are unsure about your fixtures – contact us.** We offer free evaluations of your fixtures to determine if you are eligible for rebates. We also have a list of plumbers who will do the work for you. Rebate amounts currently cover the cost of installation, but will be reduced at the end of 2014. Don't miss out on higher rebates.
