


Condition 30**Cultural Resources-Testing and Data Recovery**

If avoidance of recorded archaeological sites within any portion of the approved project design is not possible through project redesign, a phased program of site testing shall be undertaken to establish boundaries and evaluate the resources' potential eligibility to the California Register of Historical Resources under CEQA and the National Register of Historic Places under NEPA. If a site is determined ineligible, no further work is required. If a site is determined eligible, data recovery excavations shall be required to mitigate adverse effects incurred from project development.

Evidence of compliance:

Testing will be implemented as detailed in the Treatment Plan and approved by the State Historic Preservation Officer (March 2010). Refer to pages 37-48 in the Treatment Plan for specific details.
