

Condition 9	Permits-California Department of Fish and Game
<p>Prior to construction, a Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration shall be submitted by the County to the CDFG pursuant to CFG Code Section 1602. If required, a Streambed Alteration Agreement shall be obtained from the CDFG for any impacts, temporary and permanent, to any areas within the proposed project which are determined to qualify as jurisdictional streambed or riparian habitat. The County shall implement all required conditions and special considerations stipulated within the Streambed Alteration Agreement during all relevant phases of development / construction.</p>	
<p>Evidence of compliance: A site visit was conducted on March 12, 2012 with Kate Ballantyne and CDFG biologist Robb Tibstra. Mr. Tibstra recommended the County submit a Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration to CDFG for the pipeline crossing of Los Osos Creek (no other areas of the project require CDFG permits).</p> <p>A copy of the CDFG permit application is attached. The permit will be issued approximately 60 days after receipt of the application by CDFG. The Department of Public Works will provide a copy of the executed permit to the Department of Planning & Building before any work occurs in Los Osos Creek (work most likely to occur in summer, 2013). The County will implement all conditions of the CDFG permit.</p>

Dear Ms. Means:

With financial assistance from the U.S. Department of Agriculture and State Water Resources Control Board, the County of San Luis Obispo Department of Public Works proposes to construct the Los Osos Wastewater Project. Impacts to California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) jurisdictional area (attaching two pipelines to the existing Los Osos Valley Road Bridge over Los Osos Creek) will total approximately 500 sq. ft., all of which would be temporary impact. Approximately 100 feet of the project is within CDFG jurisdiction; the jurisdictional portion is addressed in this notification.

The project is located on Los Osos Valley Road, approximately 300 feet west of Lariat Drive, east of the community of Los Osos, San Luis Obispo County. The attached information package provides the necessary information to support our application for Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement. Below is a summary of the status of our other environmental permits:

CEQA Compliance

The County of San Luis Obispo is the lead agency for CEQA compliance. An Environmental Impact Report was circulated for public review to the State Clearinghouse. The Final EIR was certified by the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors on September 29, 2009. ACOE

No fill will be placed within U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) jurisdiction, therefore authorization is not required.
