Project has too many impacts to social and economic status of community. The business community will lose \$1.5 million in disposable income a month. Alternative technology is more affordable and will protect economy and ratepayers from home loss. STEP/STEG is 50% less costly. Ratepayers have the right to the more protective and affordable viable project where one exists.

Also STEP/STEG protects from seawater intrusion saving 300ACF of drinking water causing higher cost for GW losses and imported water when a sustainable alternative is available. Coastal Act requires protection of social and economic impacts Section 30006.51 TECHNICAL ADVISE TO SUPPORT COSTS... "SOCIAL, PHYSICAL AND NATURAL SCIENCES".


Section 30007 Housing and Local government "...low and moderate-income housing, replacement housing, relocation benefits..." Many residents will not be able to pay \$250.00 a month and unreasonable amount that is not in line with statewide sewer rates under \$50.00 a month. It is not the intention of the Coastal Act to gentrify the California Coastal Communities, in fact the opposite is true.

Cost is a factor if it is a socio economic impact.
