I understand that Public Works is completing an application to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for partial funding of the Los Osos Wastewater Project. In connection with that application, we understand that the USDA requires a letter from your legal counsel confirming their representation of Public Works.

This will confirm that the Office of County Counsel, San Luis Obispo County, is the legal counsel for the County of San Luis Obispo, as well as all departments of the County, including Public Works. I was appointed as County Counsel, effective September 22, 2008 for a four year term, pursuant to the authority of California Government Code section 27640 et seq., and have been the primary legal advisor to the Los Osos Wastewater Project since its inception following adoption of AB 2701 in 2006.
