a. Highway 1 Resurfacing, North of Cambria. – CalTrans

**Aileen Loe** (CalTrans) introduced **Steve Price** (CalTrans) and **Dr. Li** (UC Davis). **Dr. Li** presented a power point presentation summarizing the studies of the chip seal roughness and proposed sand seal treatments.

**Dr. Li** and **Steve Price** answered questions from the committee and the public.

The UC Davis research is providing valuable information to Caltrans for modifying pavement management practices in the future. With considerations for bicycle ride quality built into future guidance and contract specifications, similar controversy on pavement projects will be avoided in the future.

UC Davis measurements on Highway 1 this December will determine whether Caltrans' objective to smooth the surface to within an acceptable range for bicyclists has been achieved with the sand seal. Steve Price indicated that if the desired result is not achieved, further discussion would be in order.

**Elizabeth Kavanaugh** presented the Salinas River Trail Plan and discussed the next steps for the plans approval by SLOCOG. There is currently a public comment period open and this period will most likely stay open until Dec 11<sup>th</sup>. On December 4<sup>th</sup>, the plan will be presented to the SLOCOG Board.

**Ryan Chapman** provided historical information about the classification of Pine Avenue and current repair efforts as part of the Los Osos sewer project.

**Myron "Skip" Amerine** motioned that Pine Avenue be reclassified as a Class II in the bikeways plan. This action was seconded by **Robert Davis**. The motion passed.
