Tim Gillham discussed that SLOCOG and Caltrans are partnering to secure funding for the Templeton to Atascadero connector. Caltrans will now be the lead agency. **Tim** also noted that the RTP update will have many opportunities for public comment and there is currently an RFP for the Morro Bay to Cayucos connector EIR.
