III. REQUEST TO NAME BRIDGE OVER OLD CREEK AFTER COLIN REILLEY

A letter was received (attached) asking the BAC to considering naming the Bridge on the Class I bike lane in Cayucos the "Colin Reilly Memorial Bridge."

The adopted criteria for bike way naming is as follows:

- Active participation in local bike groups
- Efforts in developing bike routes or educating bike users
- Significant contribution to funding of bikeways of bike education
- Success in competitive biking events

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approve request to ask Board of Supervisors to name Old Creek bridge "Colin Reilly Memorial Bridge."**

#### IV. INFORMATION ITEMS

##### 1. Letter to Caltrans – Request to Restripe Toro Creek Bridge on Route 1

Follow-up item to the November meeting public comment regarding BAC sending attached letter to Caltrans to provide useable shoulder on existing bridge for bike passage by restriping lanes.

##### 2. Letter to SLOCOG –Request addition bike racks/lockers

Follow-up item to the November public comment regarding BAC sending requests for upcoming Unmet Transit Needs hearing to increase capacity of bike racks, particularly Route 9, to serve bike users as well as request general public bike locker availability in the San Luis Obispo downtown area.

##### 3. Update of Parks and Recreation Element Maps

At the February 2002 meeting, Josh Olejczak volunteered to be the representative from the Bicycle Advisory Committee to review the update of the Parks and Recreation Trails Plan update. Meetings of the trails group are on-going and we would expect updates as the plan is developed.

##### 4 Update of Active Bikeways Projects

B Bethel Road - We have completed plans for adding class II bike lanes on Bethel Road from Vineyard Drive to Las Tablas Road. Public works is starting the environmental determination for the project and expects to construct in Summer 2004.

– Main Street, Templeton - County Public Works intends to stripe Class II bike lanes from Gibson Road to Route 101. Construction expected June 2003.

– El Moro Avenue Bikeway - From South Bay Boulevard to 12<sup>th</sup> Street. The project has been designed and funded, and is awaiting approval by US Fish and Wildlife service to allow impact on Shoulder Banded Dune Snail. We expect to construct this project in Fall 2003.

– San Luis Bay Drive – County is developing bridge replacement project over San Luis Creek. Project scope includes providing underpass for existing Bob Jones Bike Trail. Construction expected 2005.

– Templeton - Atascadero Bikeway - Funding exists for preliminary engineering and environmental work for the project. SLOCOG and County's Parks Division staff have volunteered to oversee consultants to develop the environmental/preliminary engineering work. Parks Department will be reviewing with their Trails group to integrate recreational trails and the Anza Trail element.

- Price Canyon Road – County has consultant preparing environmental studies and project plans. Construction not expected until 2005.
