As the County Veterans Service Officer I have seen firsthand the struggles that our low income/at risk and homeless veterans face on a daily basis. These brave men and women signed up to defend our nation, when they left their homes to do so they were whole and unbroken. Though many have returned whole, there is a percentage that come home shaken and need our help in rebuilding the life they had before service.

My office will be holding a Stand Down to help these veterans in their rebuilding process. The Stand Down will be held over a 24 hour period the evening of May 18th and ending the afternoon of May 19th, 2013 at the Veterans Hall. The concept of the Stand Down is a time when troops can come home from battle to a place of safety and rest. Our Stand Down will be a way to welcome all veterans especially those returning from the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq. For 24 hours, we will provide a place where our returning warriors can access resources, receive services like medical care, legal services, employment services, and spiritual and mental care.
