Stormwater Resource Plan (SWRP)

SB 985 requires a stormwater resource plan as a condition of receiving State bond grant funds approved after January 2014 for **storm water and/or dry-weather runoff projects**

- Prop 1 IRWM Implementation Grant
- Prop 1 Stormwater Grant Program (SWGP) Round 2 Implementation
