INTAKE CONSTRUCTION NACIMIENTO WATER PROJECT (NWP)

January 24, 2007

San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) is requesting a pre-qualification package for construction of the Intake for the Nacimiento Water Project (Project).

The purpose of this pre-qualification process is to provide qualified contractors the ability to submit a Bid for District Specification 300187-08.01. This request for pre-qualification only applies to the NWP Intake for the subject contract. A separate request for pre-qualification is available for contractors intending to pre-qualify for horizontal directional drilling (HDD) services for the Project.

The District will be accepting sealed Pre-Qualification Packages in response to this request until 5:00 pm on February 13, 2007 at the following address:



PROJECT DESCRIPTION & PRE-QUALIFICATION SCHEDULE

Nacimiento Project Description

Located in the central coast of California, the San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) is implementing the Nacimiento Water Project (NWP), a raw water conveyance system to deliver 15,750 acre-feet annually from Lake Nacimiento to participating agencies including City of Paso Robles, City of San Luis Obispo, Atascadero Mutual Water Company, Templeton Community Services District, and County Service Area No. 10, Zone A. In 2005, Black & Veatch Corporation, Irvine, California, was selected to perform final design of the \$185 million project, which is scheduled to be in operation by 2010.



Intake Construction Description

A key element of the Project is the NWP Intake. As shown in Figures 1 and 2 attached, the Intake is expected to be a 20-foot diameter, 180-foot deep, concrete-lined vertical shaft which is connected to the Lake via a single 530-foot long microtunnel having a minimum diameter of 48-inches, but could be as large as 72-inches. The lake will not be drained for any of this work, and could contain water up to Elevation 800; therefore, the microtunnel will interconnect with the Lake by performing a live lake tap.

A surface-mounted sloping intake with seven ports will allow water to be drawn from various reservoir depths for optimal water quality. The intake shaft and microtunnel will be constructed in the Vaqueros Formation. The lake will be wet tapped at approximately 172 feet below top of shaft using a slurry earth pressure balance tunnel boring machine. Construction of the Intake is scheduled to begin Winter of 2007.

Construction of the Intake will be performed under District Specification 300187-08.01, scheduled to be advertised for bidding in Spring 2007. The approximate construction value of this contract is \$14 million to \$16 million.

Contractors seeking pre-qualification to submit a bid for District Specification 300187-08.01 shall demonstrate their qualifications and satisfactory prior experience contracting for and successfully completing projects involving three (3) principal work elements - 1) underwater work, 2) shaft construction, and 3) microtunneling - of a similar size and nature when compared to the NWP Intake project. The contractor shall have performed or managed the work elements.

Pre-Qualification Proposal Package Requirements

Instructions for completion of the Pre-Qualification Package are provided in the attachment titled **REQUEST FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION**. The Contractor must also complete the attachment entitled **PRE-QUALIFICATION QUESTIONNAIRE** and supporting documents, as required. The Pre-Qualification Package will be evaluated by the District and assigned a rating. Based on an evaluation of the Pre-Qualification Packages, the District will make its recommendation known to each entity who submits a Pre-Qualification Package.





Figure 1

**REQUEST FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR
INTAKE CONSTRUCTION ASSOCIATED WITH
THE NACIMIENTO WATER PROJECT
COMMENCING WITH FORTHCOMING PUBLIC WORK BID**

Notice is hereby given that the San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) has determined that all general contractors intending to submit bids for the Intake Construction Work associated with the Nacimiento Water Project must be pre-qualified. It is mandatory that all contractors who intend to submit bids fully complete the pre-qualification questionnaire, provide all materials requested herein, and be approved by the District. Bids submitted by contractors not approved by the District will not be opened at bid time.

If two or more business entities wish to bid as a Joint Venture, or expect to submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, then a member within the Joint Venture must pre-qualify.

The last date to submit a fully completed questionnaire is February 13, 2007.

Answers to questions contained in the attached questionnaire, information about current bonding capacity, and notarized statement from surety, with accompanying notes and supplemental information, are required. The District will use these documents as the basis of selecting contractors who are qualified to provide intake construction services. The District reserves the right to check other sources available. The District's decision will be based on objective evaluation criteria.

While it is the intent of the pre-qualification questionnaire and documents required therewith to assist the District in determining contractors qualified to perform the NWP Intake construction and to aid the District in selecting the lowest responsible bidder, neither the fact of pre-qualification, nor any pre-qualification rating, will preclude the District from a post-bid consideration and determination of whether a contractor has the quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the proposed work, and has demonstrated the requisite trustworthiness.

The pre-qualification packages should be submitted under seal and marked "CONFIDENTIAL" to: **SLO County FC & WCD, County Government Center, Room 207, San Luis Obispo, CA 93407; Attn: John R. Hollenbeck, P.E.**

The pre-qualification packages (questionnaire answers) submitted by contractors are not public records and are not open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. However, the contents may be disclosed to third parties for purpose of verification, or investigation of substantial allegations, or in the appeal

hearing. State law requires that the names of contractors applying for pre-qualification status shall be public records subject to disclosure. The first page of the questionnaire will be used for that purpose.

Each questionnaire must be signed under penalty of perjury in the manner designated at the end of the form, by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the Contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a Contractor becomes inaccurate, the Contractor must immediately notify the District and provide updated, accurate information in writing, under penalty of perjury.

The District reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and omissions in the information contained in the pre-qualification application submitted, to make all final determinations, and to determine at any time that the pre-qualification procedures will not be applied to a specific future public works project.

Contractors may submit pre-qualification packages during regular working hours on any day that the offices of the District are open. Contractors who submit a complete pre-qualification package will be notified of their qualification status in accordance with the pre-qualification schedule specified. The District may refuse to grant pre-qualification where the requested information and materials are not provided, or not provided by **February 13, 2007**.

Appeal Process

There is no appeal for an incomplete or late application, which have been scored not qualified as a result of incompleteness or lateness. The closing time for submission of pre-qualification packages will not be changed in order to accommodate supplementation of incomplete submissions, or late submissions.

Where a timely and completed application results in a rating below that necessary to pre-qualify, an appeal can be made. An appeal is begun by the Contractor delivering notice to the District of its appeal of the decision with respect to its pre-qualification rating, no later than ten (10) business days after notification of the list of approved subcontractors. Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the District, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding. Upon request of the Contractor, the District shall provide notification to the Contractor in writing of the basis for the Contractor's disqualification and any supporting evidence that has been received from others or adduced as a result of an investigation by the District. The Contractor shall be given the opportunity to rebut any evidence used as a basis for disqualification and to present evidence to the District as to why the Contractor should be found qualified.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal and requests a hearing, the hearing shall be conducted so that it is concluded no later than ten (10) business days after the District’s receipt of the notice of appeal. The hearing shall be an informal process conducted by a panel to whom the District Board of Supervisors has delegated responsibility to hear such appeals (the “Appeals Panel”). At or prior to the hearing, the Contractor will be advised of the basis for the District’s pre-qualification determination. The Contractor will be given the opportunity to present information and present reasons in opposition to the rating. After reviewing the evidence and at the conclusion of the hearing or no later than one (1) business day after the conclusion of the hearing, the Appeals Panel shall render its decision supported by a majority of the members of the panel. The decision of the Appeals Panel shall be final and shall not be appealable to the District’s Board of Supervisors. It is the intention of the District that the date for the submission and opening of bids will not be delayed or postponed to allow for completion of an appeal process.

Note: A contractor may be found not pre-qualified for bidding on the Nacimiento Water Project contract to be let by the District until the contractor meets the District’s requirements. In addition, a contractor may be found not pre-qualified for either:

- (1) Omission of requested information or
- (2) Falsification of information

Notice: To contractors who are using subcontractors for this job, please be advised that the District will require a post-bid qualification review of the subcontractor(s) per the qualification requirements specified in the Technical Specifications of the Contract Documents.

- b. Shaft Construction: Performing work, or managing work as prime contractor, for a project involving deep shaft construction in the 15- to 25-foot diameter range, and from 150- to 250-feet deep.
- c. Marine Construction / Underwater Work: Performing work, or managing work as prime contractor, for a project involving marine operations / underwater work (welding, sitework, concrete work, etc) in support of the work described above, with work performed in waters up to 160 feet deep.

The interview questions (interviews by the District with project managers of the contractor's clients on projects completed recently by the contractor) are included in Part III; this last category addresses the scoring of recently completed projects that are similar to this project.

Note: Not all questions in the questionnaire are scorable; but all questions must be completed for qualification. This document includes only those questions that are "scorable." The question numbers in this document correspond to numbers used in the questionnaire.

The Scores Needed for Prequalification

To pre-qualify, a contractor would be required to have a passing grade within each of the three parts referred to above.

For PART I, a passing score of **70** is required out of a maximum score of **104**.

For PART II, scoring is not applicable; rather each item answered either yes or no will determine whether a contractor is to be disqualified or not.

PART III includes questions about recently completed (public or private) construction projects. The District will interview project managers for the owners of completed projects. A passing score of **30** is required on this portion of the questionnaire, out of a maximum score of **45**.
