

CDPH: Current data on post-vaccination cases


- For the week of August 29 –September 4
 - Avg daily case rate among <u>unvaccinated</u> Californians: 71 per 100k
 - Avg daily case rate among <u>vaccinated</u> Californians: 8.9 per 100k

Vaccinated and Unvaccinated Cases, CA

From 8/24/21 to 9/4/21 –

Unvaccinated people were **8.0 times more likely** to get COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people

Third doses

 Appointments available through PH clinics or pharmacies for moderate to severely immunocompromised individuals

Visit MyTurn.ca.gov or call (833) 422-4255 to schedule

- Currently eligible for third doses:
 - Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
 - Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
 - Advanced or untreated HIV infection
 - Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response

FDA advisory panel voted to approve boosters for persons age 65+ and for persons working in high-risk congregate settings

ACIP of CDC is taking up the issue this week

Full FDA Approval for Pfizer, Age 16+


• Estimated date for vaccine eligibility age 5-11: Mid-October 2021

Vaccine Eligibility & Timeline Assumptions

Assumption	Estimation
 Immunocompromised eligible to receive additional dose 	FDA approval: August 13
2 Poostors approved for 65 L	Pfizer approval: Sept 23, 2021
2. Boosters approved for 65+	Moderna approval: Oct, 2021
	Eligibility 6 months post full vaccination
3. 5-11 age group eligible for vaccine	Est. FDA approval: Oct, 2021
4. 0-4 age group eligible for vaccine	Est. FDA approval: Dec, 2021

SLO County Vaccine Eligibility Planning

Prospective vaccine uptake in Sept – Oct:

Age 5-11:	18,638	(est. 33% uptake = 6,000)
Age 65+:	62,253	(est. 75% uptake = 41,500)
3 rd doses to date:	2,500

Preparing for Booster Availability

- PH to emphasize 1st and 2nd doses over boosters
- Unable to accommodate walk-ins for boosters due to capacity limits
- Unable to reinstate mass clinics
- Adding Saturday fixed site clinics
- Survey pediatricians
- Await State survey responses from all other providers
- Adding Phone Assistance Center staff

Childcare, K-12 and Higher Education update

- Dr. Brescia and Dr. Borenstein met with Superintendents about outbreaks, prevention strategies and planning for elementary school age vaccination
- Guidance issued for:
 - Childcare
 - Youth sports
 - Performing arts
 - Large gatherings
- Higher education update

Healthcare Providers Updates

- Most pediatric providers have become vaccine administrators
- CHC is now offering Pfizer in some clinics
- Hospital and long-term care facilities expected to offer boosters for residents and staff
