25 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that Plaintiff have
26 Judgment against Defendant as follows:

1 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

2 1. This action is brought under the laws of the State of California, and this Court
3 has jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and the parties hereto.

4 **APPLICABILITY**

5 2. All provisions of this Judgment apply to Defendant ANIKA TENE MOORE and
6 her employees, agents, successors, and assigns, to the extent permitted by law, with actual or
7 constructive knowledge of this terms Judgment (collectively, “Enjoined Persons”).

8 **INJUNCTION**

9 3. Defendant shall be and is now permanently enjoined and restrained under
10 Business and Professions Code section 17203 from violating Business and Professions Code
11 sections 2725 and 2836.1 and California Code of Regulations, Title 16, section 1474 when
12 establishing protocols as the supervising physician with a California licensed and registered
13 nurse.

14 **MONETARY RELIEF**

15 4. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code sections 17206, Defendant shall pay
16 the total of \$25,000.00 in civil penalties within 60 days of entry of Judgement to the Treasurer
17 of San Luis Obispo County care of the San Luis Obispo County District Attorney, Consumer
18 Protection Unit, Attn: Kenneth Jorgensen, 1035 Palm Street, Room 450, San Luis Obispo, CA
19 93408.

6 6. Jurisdiction shall be retained by the Court to enable any party to this Final
7 Judgment to apply to the Court at any time for such further orders, directions, modifications, or
8 terminations as may be necessary or appropriate for the construction, carry out, modification, or
9 termination of any of the injunctive provisions of this Final Judgment, and the enforcement of
10 compliance herewith; or for the punishment of violations hereunder.

11 **EFFECT OF FINAL JUDGMENT**

12 7. Nothing in this Final Judgment shall be construed as limiting, altering, or
13 otherwise affecting the rights, procedures, and protections afforded to Defendant under
14 California Business and Professions Code, nor shall a minor violation therein or under
15 California Code of Regulations that is cured be considered a violation of this Final Judgment.

16 **INTEGRATION**

17 8. This Final Judgment constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties hereto
18 and may not be amended or supplemented except as provided herein.

19 **MODIFICATION**

20 9. This Final Judgment may be modified upon written consent by all Parties and the
21 approval of the Court.

22 10. The clerk is ordered to enter this Judgment immediately, and to provide notice to
23 the Parties through counsel.
