

STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF
FINAL JUDGMENT AND
INJUNCTION

[Business and Professions Code §§
17200, 17203, & 17206]

20 Plaintiff, the People of the State of California, appearing through its attorneys, DAN
21 DOW, District Attorney for San Luis Obispo County, by Kenneth J. Jorgensen, Deputy District
22 Attorney, and Defendants CHARLES GRACE, an individual, and GRACE
23 ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, LLC., a California Corporation, (“Defendants”), and by their
24 attorney, John J. Flynn III, hereby stipulate and agree as follows.

25 1. The term “Parties,” as used hereafter, refers collectively to Plaintiff and
26 Defendants; “Defendants” shall include any subsidiaries or affiliated entities, and their/its

14 (after May 2019); CSD Law, § 61002, subpart (f).)

15 6. The Parties to this Stipulation consent to the immediate entry of the Judgment in
16 the form attached and labeled as Exhibit 1, “Final Civil Judgment and Order According to
17 Stipulation” (“Final Judgment”), before the taking of any proof and without trial or adjudication
18 of any fact or law.

19 7. Defendants acknowledge that the Superior Court of the State of California,
20 County of San Luis Obispo, has jurisdiction of the subject matter hereto, and has personal
21 jurisdiction over Defendant.

22 8. Payments are to be made according to the provisions set forth in the Final
23 Judgment.

24 9. Defendants and their attorneys acknowledge the Final Judgment is a fair and
25 reasonable resolution of matters alleged in the People’s Complaint.

26 10. The Parties waive any right to set aside the Final Judgment through any collateral
27 attack, and further waive their right to ap
