23	On or about June 20, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the				
24	crime of Conspiracy To Commit A Crime in violation of PC182(a)(1), a Felony, was				
25	committed in that JOHN ALLEN WEBB JR did unlawfully conspire together and with				
26	another person and persons whose identity is ur				
27	for Sale of a Controlled Substance, in violation of				
28	Code, a felony; that pursuant to and for the purpose of carrying out the objectives and				
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1	purposes of the aforesaid conspiracy, the said defendant committed the following overt act

7	3. On June 20, 2023, Richard Bales messaged Defendant John Webb that "Shane" will be

20 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences

21 can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

22 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,

23 sophistication, and professionalism.

4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary
value.

26 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

27 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit

28 the offense.

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1	4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code
2	and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be
3	imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal
4	Code.
5	4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger
6	to society.
7	4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in
8	juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.
9	4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section
10	1170(h).
11	4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release
12	community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.
13	4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post
14	release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.
