1	Bus is defined as any vehicle with passenger capacity of 20 or more.
2	Biddle Park, Nipomo Park, and El Chorro Park.
3	A special use permit may be required if a fee is charged or money collected, alcohol and/or food is sold, the park will be used beyond its normal capacity or range of user activities, the proposed use is likely to infringe on other users, or the event will exceed 300 in attendance.
4	Group day use service charge does not apply to Santa Margarita Lake and Lopez Lake Group Picnic facilities.
5	Driver must produce valid permanent disabled license plates from California Department of Motor Vehicles
6	Seniors: 62 years of age and older; Child: 17 years of age and under
7	Swimming-Fees apply to swimming at the following county-owned pools: Santa Margarita Lake pool; Hardie Park pool; Shamel Park pool; CW Clarke Park pool; Templeton pool; and San Miguel pool. (No daily swimming fee is charged at Santa Margarita Lake Pool.
8	Maximum rental 8 hours for ball field, 4 hours per week for tennis courts. Special Use Permit required for longer term rentals.
9	Special discount representing up to 100% reduction may be issued by the Director--Parks & Recreation for promotional use at any County park facility.
10	If the applicant, sponsoring organizations, staff, or performer has previously been involved in an event which required County to clean or repair the premises, the Parks & Recreation Department may prohibit subsequent use by any such organization.
11	Event Center rates will be determined based upon amenities rented (kitchen, hall, BBQ area, tables, chairs)
14	Fee collection may be temporarily waived by the Director--Parks & Recreation for a Parks fee if equivalent financial sponsorship is provided to offset revenue loss.
16	Large Special Events, ie, Renaissance Festival, Triathlon, etc. Fees subject to negotiation and approval by Director--Parks & Recreation.
