Registrations will be accepted beginning December 1, 2020. **You must register prior to working as a Farm Labor Contractor in San Luis Obispo County in 2021.** Registration is required on an annual basis.

#### Registration Requirements:

1. All companies are asked to register by mail.
  - a. Mail the required documents to the San Luis Obispo County Agricultural Commissioner  
2156 Sierra Way Suite A, San Luis Obispo CA 93401
  - b. A copy of your registration and receipt will be mailed back to you, along with any applicable information regarding regulatory updates.
2. Required documents
  - a. Farm Labor Contractor State License, **good for 2021.**
  - b. Completed Farm Labor Contractor Registration form

Select the "Pesticide Use Enforcement" program and then the "Pesticide Use Registrations" link.
  - c. Registration Fee is \$25

#### Important Information:

1. For all fieldworker and pesticide applicator employee pesticide safety trainings, **the person conducting the training must hold one of the following qualifications:**
  - CA certified applicator or any other valid license or certificate of personal pesticide qualification issued by the department
  - Completion of an "instructor training" program through the University of California (UC) Integrated Pest Management Program
  - CA Registered Professional Forester
  - County Biologist who holds a pesticide program license
  - UC Extension Advisor
  - There may be other approved qualifications. Please contact our office if you have any questions.
