**You must register prior to performing any pest control work in 2022.**

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#### Registration Requirements:

1. All companies are asked to register by mail
  - a. Mail the required documents to the San Luis Obispo County Agricultural Commissioner  
2156 Sierra Way Suite A, San Luis Obispo CA 93401.
  - b. A copy of your registration and receipt will be mailed back to you, along with any applicable information regarding regulatory updates.
  - c. Contact your closest office to renew your Restricted Materials Permit if you have one.
2. Required Documents:
  - a. Copy of Maintenance Gardener Pest Control Business License from DPR. **Good through 2022**
  - b. Qualified Applicator Certificate, or Qualified Applicator License. **Good through 2022**
  - c. Completed Registration Form and updated Equipment List
    - i. Registration Forms and Equipment Lists are available with this letter or at our website:

Select the "Pesticide Use Enforcement" program and then the "Pesticide Use Registrations" link.
  - d. Registration Fee is \$25  
Payment Options:  
Check (*Checks payable to the Agricultural Commissioner*)  
Mastercard, Visa, Discover, American Express (*in person or call for online payment options*)  
Cash (*In person only*)

#### Important Messages:

1. **Pesticide Use Reporting Requirements:** Maintenance Gardeners must submit monthly use reports each month by the 10th day of the following month from the application. A Negative Use Report is required for those months during which no pest control work is performed and is also due by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month.
2. **Carbaryl:** As of August 1, 2020, Carbaryl (Sevin) is a California Restricted Material and can only be applied by a certified applicator. Please contact this Department for more information.
3. **Licensing:** We continue to find unlicensed maintenance gardeners. We encourage you to report suspected unlicensed activity. We accept anonymous calls at (800) 528-9333 or call our main office at (805) 781-5910.
4. **California Code of Regulations 6602, Labeling Available at Use Site:** A copy of the registered labeling that allows the manner in which the pesticide is being used shall be available at each use site. Digital or physical formats are acceptable, however if an electronic device fails and the digital format cannot be viewed, then the user is in violation of 6602.
