#### Registration Requirements:

1. Pest Control Advisors are asked to register by mail.
  - a. Mail the required documents to the San Luis Obispo County Agricultural Commissioner  
2156 Sierra Way, Suite A, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401
  - b. A copy of your registration and receipt will be mailed back to you, along with any applicable information on regulatory changes.
2. Required Documents:
  - a. A copy of your Pest Control Advisor card, **good through 2023**
  - b. Completed Registration Form

Select the "Pesticide Use Enforcement" program and then the "Pesticide Use Registrations" link.
  - c. Registration Fees:  
\$10 if based in San Luis Obispo County  
\$5 if based outside of San Luis Obispo County  
\*Based on the address listed on your PCA card  
Payment Options:  
Check (payable to the *Agricultural Commissioner*)  
Mastercard, Visa, Discover, American Express (*In person or call for online payment options*)  
Cash (*in person only*)

#### Important Information:

- 1) Effective August 1, 2020, **Carbaryl (Sevin)** is a California Restricted Material, except when formulated as a bait labeled only for agricultural use.
- 2) **Paraquat Dichloride Human Health Mitigation Decision** all paraquat handlers (mixing, loading and applying) must be certified applicators **and** must complete the EPA Paraquat Training module.
- 3) All permits/OIN's within ¼ mile of a schools and day care centers must submit an annual notification of pesticides, which they expect to use, between July 1- June 30. To submit annual notification of pesticides or add new pesticides, use the online form DPR-ENF-150 or log into Calagpermits.org. New active ingredients and/or products may be added throughout the year with 48-hour notice. Please ask the grower for a copy of the list that was submitted, to verify your recommendation is listed or if an addition needs to be made.
