Dear Voter,

San Luis Obispo County Voter Registration and Elections is sending this Unsigned Ballot Statement because you did not sign your ballot envelope as required by Election Code 3011 (b). You have 8 days after the polls close on November 6, 2018, to complete, sign and return this Unsigned Ballot Statement. You may also come in to the San Luis Obispo office to sign your original Vote by Mail ballot envelope. You must do this within eight (8) days following the election to ensure your Vote by Mail ballot is counted as required by Election Code 3019 (f).

REGARDLESS OF HOW YOUR UNSIGNED BALLOT STATEMENT IS RETURNED, IT MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE COUNTY CLERK-RECORDER'S OFFICE NO LATER THAN 5:00 P.M., NOVEMBER 14TH, EIGHT (8) DAYS FOLLOWING THE ELECTION.

You must use one of the following options:

- Mail your signed statement in the enclosed envelope to our office. Postmarks will not count. If you choose to return your ballot via mail, be sure there is sufficient postage.
Email the signed statement to elections@co.slo.ca.us.
Fax the signed statement to our office. Vote by Mail Fax number (805) 781-1111 or (805) 461-6044.
Drop off your signed statement at any polling place on Election Day. You may drop off your Unsigned Ballot Statement at any polling place before the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, November 6, 2018.
Come to our office in person. You may come to our office to SIGN your original Vote by Mail ballot envelope or return the Unsigned Ballot Statement.

**READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE STATEMENT. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.**

1. In order to ensure that your vote by mail ballot will be counted, your statement should be completed and returned as soon as possible so that it can reach the elections official of the county in which your precinct is located no later than 5 p.m. on the eighth day after the election.
2. You must sign your name on the line above (Voter's Signature).
3. Place the statement into a mailing envelope addressed to your local elections official. Mail, deliver, or have delivered the completed statement to the elections official. Be sure there is sufficient postage if mailed and that the address of the elections official is correct.
4. Alternatively, you may submit your completed statement by facsimile or email transmission to your local elections official, or submit your completed statement to a polling place within the county or a ballot drop-off box before the close of the polls on Election Day.

I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means that my vote by mail ballot will be invalidated.
