Dear Voter,

San Luis Obispo County Voter Elections is sending this Signature Verification Statement because while processing your vote-by-mail ballot for the November 6, 2018, General Election, we found that your signature on the ballot envelope does not match the signature on your voter registration card as required by Election Code 3011 (b). If they do not compare, the vote by mail envelope cannot be opened and the ballot is not counted.

YOUR SIGNATURE VERIFICATION STATEMENT
MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE COUNTY CLERK-RECORDER'S OFFICE
BY 5:00 P.M., ON NOVEMBER 28TH, TWO DAYS PRIOR
TO THE EXPECTED CERTIFICATION OF THE ELECTION.

You must use one of the following options:

- Mail your signed statement in the enclosed envelope to our office. Postmarks will not count. If you choose to return your ballot via mail, be sure there is sufficient postage.
Email the signed statement to elections@co.slo.ca.us.
Fax the signed statement to our office. Vote by Mail Fax number (805) 781-1111 or (805) 461-6044.
Come to our office in person. You may come to our offices to SIGN your original Vote by Mail ballot envelope or return the Signature Verification Statement.
Drop off your signed statement at any polling place on Election Day. You may drop off your Signature Verification Statement at any polling place before the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, November 6, 2018.

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE STATEMENT. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.

1. We have determined that the signature you provided on your vote-by-mail ballot does not match the signature(s) on file in your voter record. In order to ensure that your vote-by-mail ballot will be counted, the Signature Verification Statement must be completed and returned as soon as possible.
2. The Signature Verification Statement must be received by the elections official of the county where you are registered to vote no later than 5 p.m. two days prior to certification to the election.
3. You must sign your name below where specified on the Signature Verification Statement (Voter's Signature).
4. Place the Signature Verification Statement into a mailing envelope addressed to your local elections official. Mail, deliver, or have the completed Signature Verification Statement delivered to the elections official. Be sure there is sufficient postage if mailed and that the address of the elections official is correct.
5. If you not wish to send the Signature Verification Statement by mail or have it delivered, you may submit your completed Signature Verification Statement by email or facsimile transmission to your local elections official using the information provided.

I am a resident of the precinct in which I have voted, and the person whose name appears on the vote by mail ballot envelope. I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means that my vote by mail ballot will be invalidated.
