

- The deadline for return of Vote By Mail ballots is 8:00pm, Tuesday, June 7, 2016. Mailed ballots must be postmarked before or on Election Day and be received in the Clerk-Recorder's office no later than three days after Election Day to be counted. On Election Day you may return your ballot to any polling place, including our offices, in San Luis Obispo County between 7:00am and 8:00pm. Polling places for this election are listed in this booklet. Ballots received after 8:00pm, June 7, 2016 MAY NOT BE COUNTED.
- **Spoiled Ballot?** If you make a mistake, tear or deface any portion of your ballot, replace the spoiled ballot in the I.D. Return Envelope and follow the instructions on the envelope to receive another ballot.

### PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

### **Presidential Nominee Contest is "Party-Nominated"**

- The Presidential Primary contest continues to be a partisan office, elected by voters affiliated with each party.
- Only those voters who are registered with a specific party can vote that party's ballot (with the exception of cross over voters – see below).
- Voters registered with a qualified political party cannot vote another party's ballot.
- Check on your voter registration status and party affiliation at www.slovote.com
- The rules for non-partisan contests (i.e. County Supervisor) did not change and will appear on every ballot.

### **Cross Over Voting**

- The ballots are comprised of 6 different party ballots and a Non-Partisan ballot. Voters who are listed as No Party Preference (formerly Decline to State) voters can vote the Non-Partisan ballot (no Presidential race) or cross over and vote a party ballot from the <u>American Independent</u>, <u>Democratic</u>, and <u>Libertarian</u> parties only.
- To vote a <u>Green</u>, <u>Peace and Freedom</u>, or <u>Republican</u> party ballot, one must be registered with the respective party.
- Again, if you are already affiliated with one of the parties listed above, you will be issued that party's ballot.

### Top Two "Voter-Nominated" Contests

- Applies to U.S. Senate, U.S. Congressional, Statewide and State legislative offices.
- All voter-nominated contests will appear on every ballot. Candidates, regardless of their party preference, will appear on a single combined ballot and voters can vote for any candidate from any political party.
- Only the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes cast in the Primary Election are on the ballot for the General Election.
- Write-in candidates are not allowed for these contests during the General Election.

## STATEMENT OF CANDIDATE FOR U.S. REPRESENTATIVE. 24<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

Age: 56

WILLIAM "BILL" OSTRANDER

**Occupation:** Farmer/Director of Non-Profit Citizens Congress
