## Former Arroyo Grande High School Teacher Pleads No Contest to Felony Unlawful Intercourse Sentenced to County Jail for 6 months

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA, April 6, 2017 – Former Arroyo Grande High School teacher Tara Stumph pled no contest today to felony Unlawful Intercourse with a Minor More Than Three Years Younger than her, a violation of Penal Code section 261.5(c).

Superior Court Judge Gayle Peron sentenced Ms. Stumph to serve 180 days in County Jail and four years on felony probation including standard "Sex Offender Management Program" terms. Ms. Stumph's sex offender terms include a special counseling program and an order to stay away from middle school or high school age children and schools.

This case was investigated by Arroyo Grande Police Department and prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Rebecca Speer-Mathews.
