COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will focus on the causes, prevalence, prevention and treatment of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder and the impact that social workers, probation officers, educators, medical personnel, and legal professionals can have on the future of children and their families who are at risk of, or are already affected by this condition.

Upon completion of the course, attendees will be able to:

1. Identify which substance of all of the drugs of abuse is the most devastating to a developing fetus.
2. Identify the three disorders that fall within the spectrum of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) including Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (FAS), Partial Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (pFAS), and Alcohol Related Neurodevelopmental Disorder (ARND).
3. Learn the prevalence rate of FASD in first grade children in San Diego County and recognize that this is twice the rate of Autism Spectrum Disorder.
4. Identify at least two specific intervention programs that have been developed to treat children with FAS, pFAS and ARND.
