  - Anne reviewed Care Court: CARE Court is a proposed framework to deliver
    mental health and substance use disorder services to the most severely impaired
    Californians who too often languish suffering in homelessness or incarceration –
    without the treatment they desperately need. They are focusing on people with
    schizophrenia spectrum or other psychotic disorders who lack medical decisionmaking capacity before they enter the criminal justice system or become so
    impaired that they end up in a Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Mental Health
    Conservatorship.

- The Housing Services Oversight Committee (HSOC) just met. Currently looking at all resources to build shelter and temporary housing and eventually permanent supportive housing.
