• Anne reviewed Care Court: CARE Court is a proposed framework to deliver mental health and substance use disorder services to the most severely impaired Californians who too often languish – suffering in homelessness or incarceration – without the treatment they desperately need. They are focusing on people with schizophrenia spectrum or other psychotic disorders who lack medical decisionmaking capacity – before they enter the criminal justice system or become so impaired that they end up in a Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Mental Health Conservatorship.
