

Crisis Stabilization Unit Walk In Hours & Information



Starting 4/1/2021 SLO CSU will be accepting walk in clients 10AM- 9 PM 7 DAYS A WEEK

Clients will be evaluated at the CSU. If determined to be voluntary and appropriate they will be admitted to the CSU if they desire services.

All clients placed on a WIC 5150 during walk in evaluations require medical clearance from the ED. Clients will be transported to the ED by CSU staff and can return after receiving medical clearance if they are appropriate for the CSU.

Clients will need to meet the following criteria for admission:

18 years or older.
Must have all prescribed medication with them or have someone able to bring them the
medications.
No suspicion of Alzheimer's/neurocognitive decline.
ETOH (alcohol level) needs to be below 0.200 with no risk of withdrawal/DTs.
Not intoxicated or having withdrawals from other substances & be unable to participate
in a therapeutic milieu.
No clients experiencing symptoms of withdrawal from narcotics/benzodiazepines.
No open draining wounds requiring more than daily dressing changes. Must be ruled
out for MRSA, VRE or ESBL. If positive, be on antibiotics for 24 hours. (CDC guidelines)
Client must be redirectable and not currently showing signs of aggression or
hypermania.
Does not have an acute medical condition requiring immediate attention.
No PC 290's.
