## **Hazardous Material:**

A material can be considered hazardous if it is flammable, ignitable, corrosive or toxic. Examples include: Oil, Gasoline, propane, antifreeze, pesticides.

Examples include spills or discharge from RVs, septic systems, or line breaks:
