



Workplace Guidance: Worker Positive for COVID-19

If a place of work receives notification that a worker has tested positive for COVID-19 (or a symptomatic worker is awaiting COVID-19 test results), the facility is required to take the following actions:

1. Ensure the affected employee is **excluded** from the facility.
2. Inform employees of their possible exposure to COVID-19 in the workplace (but maintain confidentiality about individual employee's identity). Perform daily checks to ensure fellow employees are not sick.
3. Remind workers with COVID-19 to follow the CDC's [What to do if you are sick with coronavirus disease 2019 \(COVID-19\)](#) guidance and return to work only when cleared to do so by the County Public Health Department.
4. Clean and sanitize the facility in accordance with [CDC Guidance](#), using a product from the list of cleaning products approved for use against the virus that causes COVID-19 available on the [EPA website](#).
