Important Notice Regarding COVID-19

TEMPORARY MEETING PROCEDURES

Until further notice all public meetings for the County of San Luis Obispo Health Commission will be closed to members of the public and non-essential County staff. This measure is based on the threat of COVID-19 as reflected in the Proclamations of Emergency issued by both the Governor of the State of California and the San Luis Obispo County Emergency Services Director as well as the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020, relating to the convening of public meetings in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Below are instructions on how to view the meeting remotely and how to provide public comment. Additionally, hearing body members and officers may attend the meeting via teleconference and participate in the meeting to the same extent as if they were present.

Agendas Posted in Public Locations

Agendas will still be physically posted outside of the New Government Center entrance at 1055 Monterey Street and outside of the Public Health Building at 2191 Johnson Avenue.

How to Provide Verbal Public Comment via Telephone (Voicemail Only)

- 3. Leave your comment.

Please Note: Verbal comments are limited to 3 minutes including stating your name. Please limit your comment to one (1) agenda item per message. If you would like to comment on multiple agenda items, you are requested to leave a separate message for each item. Deadline: Verbal comments (voicemails) must be received by the Clerk no later than 4:00 PM the day before the noticed meeting. Every effort will be made to play your comment aloud at the meeting. However, some

comments may not be included due to the time limitations or technical issues. All comments will be entered into the administrative record and provided to each hearing body member or officer.

How to Provide Public Comment via Email or Mail

Please email or mail your comment to Michael J. Coughlin, Clerk of the County of San Luis Obispo Health Commission. Please include the term "Public Comment" in the title of your email/letter and provide the hearing date and agenda item you are commenting about. Written Comment received by email or U.S. Mail will be placed into the administrative record and forwarded to each hearing body officer or member. Deadline: Public comments can be submitted and taken into the administrative record any time via email or U.S. Mail up until the close of the hearing for that item. For written comments to be more effective, we encourage you to submit written comments at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, which will provide the hearing body members or officer a better opportunity to review the correspondence.

ITEM: Review & Approve CAPSLO's Request for Community COVID Education to a Parent Audience

ACTION REQUIRED:

It is requested that the Health Commission review and approve the request, including the recommendations made by the Community Education Committee.

SUMMARY NARRATIVE:

Community Action Partnership of San Luis Obispo (CAPSLO) has requested that the Health Commission provide community-based education to a parent audience at their 12 childcare site locations regarding the COVID-19 vaccine that includes addressing the science, safety, efficacy and access.

This request was discussed in-depth by the Community Education Committee at their May 7, 2021 meeting.

At the meeting, the Community Education Committee voted unanimously to approve the request with the following recommendations:

- 1. The Health Commission should move forward with CAPSLO's request to provide educational presentation on COVID vaccine science, how to obtain vaccine, address vaccine myths and common questions and provide general information on COVID safety.
- 2. The presentation should be unbranded and should be developed by a team of Health Commission members utilizing existing resources and information from the Public Health Department.
- 3. The presentation should be pre-recorded for use at multiple CAPSLO sites.
- 4. It is recommended to conduct a pilot live presentation session for first parent audience in June.

STAFF COMMENTS:

Staff recommends the approval of the request. Upon approval, staff recommend the appointment of an ad-hoc committee, primarily comprised of Community Education Committee members to develop the presentation. Additionally, the Community Education Committee would request Commissioners, who have a health background or interest, serve as presenters.
