COVID-19 Vaccine Update: Vaccine Available for Residents 75 and Over Starting Monday, Jan. 18

Beginning Monday, January 18, **SLO County residents age 75 or older** will be eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine, as the first part of Phase 1b. Residents over 75 are first in line in Phase 1b because people age 75 and older are at higher risk for serious COVID-19 illness or death than other age groups, and allocating the County's limited vaccine supply to this group will help prevent the most serious outcomes.

Health care workers who provide direct, in-person clinical care within San Luis Obispo County continue to be eligible. Residents and staff of long-term care facilities continue to receive vaccine through federal pharmacy partnerships.

The County Public Health Department is providing the vaccine **by appointment only** to eligible residents and health care workers. To make an appointment, visit:

Residents age 75 and older will be asked to provide documents showing their current age (drivers' license, state ID, passport, birth certificate, etc.) and that they currently live in SLO County (drivers' license, state ID, copy of lease, official mail received at a SLO County address, etc.). Health care workers will be asked to provide photo ID and most recent pay stub showing San Luis Obispo County health care employer information.

Please remind your patients not to sign up for an appointment until they are eligible to do so. They will be turned away if they are not eligible, and this slows down the process for everyone.

We are working as swiftly as possible to vaccinate this group and will announce widely when vaccine is available to more SLO County residents. For updates:
