COVID-19 Vaccine Authorized for Children Under Age Five

Two COVID-19 vaccines have now received Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for children under age five by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA), and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) and Western States Scientific Safety Review Workgroup. Options for this age group include:
